An excellent insight

This book gives an excellent insight for a student of my age and stage of experience. Packed full of information about the field, and what sort of person you have to be to become a speech and language therapist, it also gives tips for university interviews. As the authors are both speech and language therapy lecturers, they know what needs to be heard in the interview situation, and their advice will be taken on board. The many case studies, explaining the problems and the treatment used, offer a useful insight into everyday life in the clinic.

Very easy to read, as it is split down into small sections, this book will be most enjoyable to a student thinking about a career in speech and language therapy or to a careers advisor who knows little about the subject. Definitely value for money - I would recommend it to anyone interested in this field.
